## We've completed our targeted consultation at Weston Marsh

We shared more detail about Route Section 5, including two new substations, associated infrastructure and the earlier delivery of Weston Marsh A, as part of the 140 km Grimsby to Walpole overhead line and substations project.

## What's next?

### 1 Reviewing feedback and survey data

We're reviewing all feedback alongside ongoing technical and environmental surveys. This work helps us understand the local area better and informs the evolving design.

### 2 Continuing technical and environmental work

Our survey teams remain active, carrying out assessments that will help us finalise the project and make informed decisions.

### 3 Supporting the local community

We're committed to giving back to communities. We'll be establishing a community fund to support long-lasting local improvements. So far, we've heard from more than 150 residents about how they would like the fund to be used in their local area. We'll share more information soon on how we plan to take these ideas forward.

### 4 Application submissions

We're working towards submitting our Town and Country Planning Application (TCPA) and Section 37 application for works at Weston Marsh A in the coming months, which will allow us to connect homegrown power sooner.

We're then planning to submit our Development Consent Order (DCO) application in 2027.
